# Grant Updates (Grant Funding Received \$137,871)

With our first Trillium grant we were able to renovate our kitchen and women's bathroom, hopefully they will be fully operational by opening day. With our 2<sup>nd</sup> Trillium Grant, we were able to hire our league coordinator. Please welcome Steve Kenny when you see him at the club. As well, this grant paid for Club Coach Training. Ted Stewart, Lynn Beaton and Steve Kenny will be fully trained by the end of May. We were also able to buy some new sets of bowls.

Over the winter we were also successful obtaining a 2<sup>nd</sup> New Horizon Grant. This grant allowed us to purchase even more bowls for a total of 16 new 0000 and 000 bowl sets. This will be helpful for our new bowlers and junior players. We also have new score boards and slings for all our sets of bowls. With this grant we are update our equipment room with new shelving for our bowls and a new shelving system in the entry way for member bowls and club information. Last year we received the 1<sup>st</sup> New horizon grant that we used to improve our greens and build the new benches.

Within the last two years Owen Sound Roselawn Bowling Club has received 2 Trillium Grants and 2 New Horizon Grants for a total of \$137,871 in funding. Cleve still can't believe it. When you do see Cleve this year, please give him a big thank you for all the <u>time and energy</u> he has spent on our greens and the big renovations of the kitchen and bathroom.
